OSHA Mandatory Trainings / (Safe Schools Requirements)

Question: If I took them last year (FY 16-17 school year) do I need to take them again this year FY 17-18?

Answer: Yes, you will need to take all 7 OSHA trainings this school year (FY 17-18).

Question: If I was a new substitute or re-hire and took all OSHA trainings in April, May or June do I need to take them again?

Answer: Yes, you will need to take all 7 Required OSHA trainings for the FY 17-18 school year.

Question: I am a returning substitute do I need to take all 7 OSHA trainings?

Answer: Yes, returning and new hire substitutes are required to take all 7 mandatory OSHA trainings.

Question: I am being hired in a regular position do I still need to take the OSHA trainings?





Answer: Yes, they are required by **all** school district employees.

All District Personnel must take:

- Bloodborne Pathogens Exposure Prevention
- Fire Extinguisher Safety
- Hazard Communications (Right to Understand) GHS
- Safety Data Sheets (GHS)
- Bullying: Recognition & Response
- Asbestos Awareness
- Active Shooter
